Dryer Vents

Back in fall I remember one of the news channels airing a clip about dryer vent cleaning, most are not aware of potential problems that can arise when vents become laden with lint. For one thing, a lot of energy is wasted because the clothes do not dry properly due to lack of air flow through the appliance. Most loads should dry in 40-50 minutes, so when you notice the clothes are still damp you run the dryer another 10 minutes or so – that costs money. The build up of lint could also be a good ignition source. Call us to clean your dryer vent!
