WET WINDOWS

This is the season we hear so many complaints of sweating windows, especially in newer

constructed homes. A few tips to remedy this situation:

- 1) Remove inside screen so air can flow across window easier,
- 2) Allow air to flow behind shades or blinds by allowing a 1-2" gap at the window sill,
- 3) Run the furnace blower constantly for continuous air movement,
- 4) After showering, leave bath fan run 20 minutes to exhaust as much humidity as possible,
- 5) Check your humidistat setting if you have an automatic humidifier,
- 6) If all these tips fail, we can install a heat recovery ventilator.

AIR FILTERS

Furnaces have been on now for about one month. Don't forget to check your filter. If you need replacement filters, you can either stop by our office or call us for a free drop off when we are in the area. Office hours: Monday – Thursday 7:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Friday 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
