Planned Maintenance

Reminder cards will follow shortly to remind you of your A/C maintenance. This year the cards are yellow! The blue was getting depressing. Call early for a better chance of getting the day you would like. For those not signed up as Planned Maintenance customers I encourage you to have you're A/C tuned up also. Low Freon, pitted contactors, loose wires, sticky bearings or plugged condensate hoses lead to higher operating costs, decreased comfort or expensive repairs.

Extended Warranties

If your furnace came with an extended parts and labor warranty the factory is tightening their belts when it comes to yearly service performed on the covered equipment. If yearly service cannot be proved they will start denying any warranty claims processed by us. Your furnace and air conditioner is a vital piece of equipment that requires yearly maintenance. Just as your cars need oil changes / tune ups at given intervals. I'm sure you wouldn't drive it for 2-10 yrs without any maintenance like some homeowners treat their heating/cooling equipment.

Honey do list

A few reminders to add to the list would be:

- Replace air filter on furnace
- Uncover A/C, if you cover it
- Have us tune up the equipment
- If bushes or evergreens are too close to the unit, trim them back
- Turn on circuit breaker
- Any visible signs of mice in unit?
- Is A/C level? Be careful if you level the unit
- Caulk any gaps on house where A/C & electrical lines come out
